



Constitution

1. Name

The name of the Association shall be the PEÑA FLAMENCA DE LONDRES.

2. Aims

The aims of the Association shall be to promote all aspects of flamenco and Spanish dancing.

3. Powers

The Association shall have the power to do all permissible things desirable for the attainment of its aims.

4. Committee

The management of the Association shall be the responsibility of a Committee consisting of between seven and thirteen Committee Members.

5. Sub-Committees

The Committee shall have the power to constitute such sub-committees as it considers desirable.

6. Membership

Membership shall be open to any person interested in furthering the Association's aims and who pays the requisite subscription, subject to any legitimate restrictions which may be applied by the Committee at its discretion.

7. Subscriptions

The Committee shall from time to time determine subscription rates, and may at its discretion waive or reduce subscriptions for specified categories of members, including honorary members.

8. Meetings

a) Ordinary Meetings shall be held regularly and shall be open to all members and to such visitors as agreed by the Committee.

- b) An Annual General Meeting shall be held at the beginning of each year of the Association at which a Committee shall be elected, each Committee Member being elected for a term of two years.
- c) Any nomination of a member for election to the Committee shall be submitted in writing to the Committee 14 days before an Annual General Meeting.
- d) As vacancies arise, the Committee shall have the power to co-opt further members onto the Committee to serve until the next Annual General Meeting.
- e) Special General Meetings shall be held either at the direction of the Committee or at the written request of ten members or of one-quarter of the membership, whichever is the greater.
- f) The Committee shall give members 14 days' notice of any General Meeting.
- g) Any resolution to be considered by a General Meeting shall be duly seconded and shall be submitted in writing to the Committee 28 days before the General Meeting.
- h) General Meetings shall be open to members only, and shall have a quorum when eight members are present.

9. Amendment

This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds majority of members present at a General Meeting.

10. Dissolution

- a) The Association may be dissolved by a two-thirds majority of members at a General Meeting.
- b) Any funds of the dissolved Association shall be transferred to one or more associations or organisations having aims similar to the Association and approved at a General Meeting.
